



A PLEDGE OF COMMITMENT TO THE NATIONAL REFORMS PROCESS AND ON THE PASSING OF THE 11TH AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION BILL (OMNIBUS CONSTITUTIONAL BILL) AND OTHER RELATED BILLS IN AND TO BE TABLED BEFORE PARLIAMENT REQUIRED FOR PEACE AND STABILITY IN **LESOTHO**

WE, THE POLITICAL PARTIES REPRESENTED IN THE TENTH (10TH) PARLIAMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF LESOTHO:

RECALLING the commitment made on the 06th April, 2017 by all the Political Parties in Lesotho as well as Civil Society Formations to give implementation of the National Reforms the highest priority for purposes of stability, security, peace and reconciliation;

FURTHER RECALLING that the Government and all Political Parties in Lesotho signed a Memorandum of Agreement on the Lesotho Reforms Process on 04 July, 2019 in terms of which they, among others, committed to removing all obstacles and impediments which may unduly delay,

undermine or derail the reform process, save for the clauses that have been struck off by the Courts of Law;

COGNIZANT of the fact that the reforms are an embodiment of the vision and aspirations of Basotho on the Lesotho they want, and are intended to anchor a future Lesotho that is politically stable so that every Mosotho could freely attain their aspirations; a future where all our institutions and sectors are allowed and enabled to excel and are fully accountable under democratic norms; a future where the three Arms of Government work collaboratively and synergistically; a future where people-centred development is the major preoccupation of the government of the day; a future where people live in a safe and just society and where human rights are fully guaranteed for all;

COMMENDING the National Reforms Authority (NRA) for the significant strides it has made in the implementation of the reforms under the seven agreed thematic areas within the statutory period of twelve (12) to eighteen (18) months in accordance with the NRA Act No.4 of 2019;

Appreciative of the enormous support and good will that SADC, the SADC Facilitation Team and our Development Partners have extended to Lesotho in the implementation of the reforms;

AWARE of our shared responsibility to take ownership of the destiny of our nation and to facilitate as well as offer leadership in the execution of

the reforms;

- We re-affirm our commitment to the National Reforms Process, and constructive engagement and expeditious implementation of the reforms.
- 2. We assure all Basotho of our dedication and commitment to change the course of our beloved Kingdom and urge Honourable Members of Parliament to fast track the process and pass the 11th Amendment to the Constitution Bill and related legislative instruments before the end of June 2022.
- We will exercise fidelity over the aspirations of Basotho on the Lesotho they Want as espoused in the Multi-stakeholder Plenary II Report which has informed the 11th Amendment to the Constitution Bill.
- 4. In the true spirit of the principles underpinning the reforms process, we shall remove all the obstacles and impediments that have the potential to derail or delay the passing of the 11th Amendment to the Constitution Bill.
